2009-1010 Student Guidelines

Welcome to the SBC Outreach Music Academy. To be a successful student at the Music Academy, here are some things students and parents need to know.

Fees

- Registration is \$20 per student per session (beginning in September and January). Registration is prorated for students registering after mid-session.
- Lessons are \$7.00 for the first student in a family, and \$5.00 for subsequent students.
- Lesson fees are to be paid before the lesson. Checks or cash are accepted. Multiple payments are welcomed.

Attendance

- Lessons are 30 minutes in length. It's important to be punctual and prepared.
- Students are expected to attend each week that the Music Academy is open. If a scheduled lesson is to be missed, the student must contact the Music Academy and teacher well in advance of the lesson. A student with three unexcused absences must re-register.
- Be sure to bring all materials: all parts of the instrument and accessories, music, other assignment books, and a pencil.

Practice

- Students should make time to practice every day. Parents: make sure you know what your child is working on, and encourage them as much as possible. Get to know your child's teacher, and how to contact them.

Instruments

- For help with finding instruments to rent or buy contact the Music Academy office. We have agreements with local providers who can offer discounts. We also have a few instruments for students to use.

Note to parents

- Please do not leave unaccompanied children under 12 years old at the Music Academy. If they are not in a lesson, they must be in the care of an adult.

School closures

- The Music Academy generally follows School District 41's closings where weather is concerned. When in doubt, call (309) 788-0677, ext. 8.

Recitals

- The Music Academy plans at least two recitals during the school year. This is a great opportunity for students at all levels to show what they've accomplished.

Volunteering

- The Music Academy depends on volunteers! Parents and grandparents, please share what you do best. We need help with everything from greeting the students and helping with special events to fundraising and public relations. Donations are always greatly appreciated.

Live Performances

- Please make every effort to attend live performances when possible. We'll pass along announcements of opportunities as we become aware of them.
