The following are guidelines for our in-person church services.

Anyone experiencing Fever, Cough, Shortness of breath, Chills, Sore throat, Nausea, Loss of taste/smell or any other flu, cold or COVID-19 related symptoms are asked to **NOT** attend any services in-person.

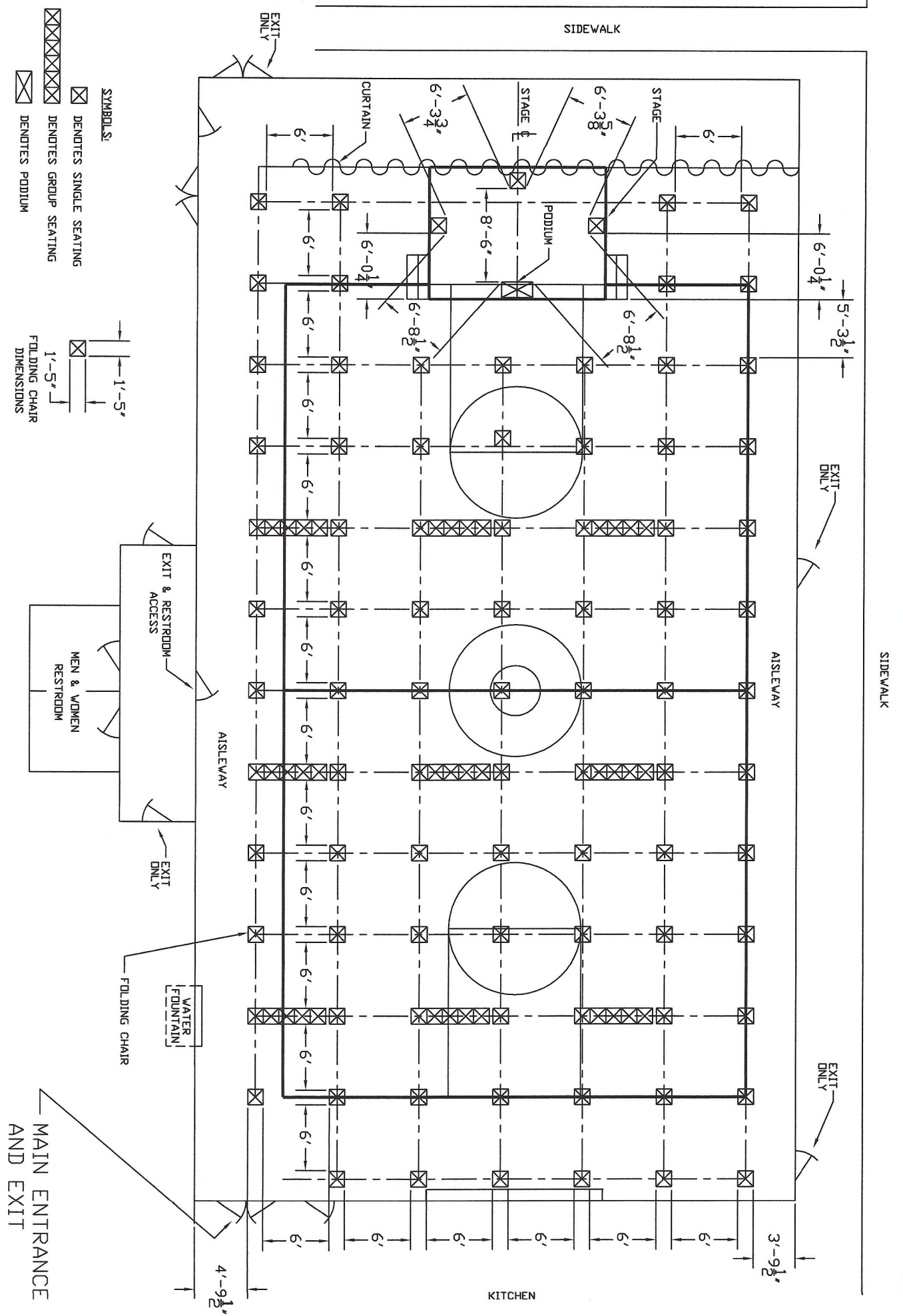
- **Sunday Worship Service will continue at 10:00am until further notice. We will continue to broadcast our services on online once in-person services resume.**
- **Sunday School will begin at 8:30am and will remain online only via Zoom.**
- **In-person worship service will be held in the SBC Family Life Center. All attendees must enter via the FLC entrance only.**
- **All individuals entering the SBC campus 2 years of age and up will be required to wear a face mask at all times.**
- **All attendees entering will have their temperature checked. Attendee's temperatures must be below 100.4 degrees to attend in-person service.**
- **Seating in the FLC has been specifically arranged for social distancing. (See enclosed seating diagram) Please follow the direction of the ushers. Please **DO NOT** move or rearrange seating layout at any time.**
- **Please avoid shaking or holding hands with anyone except for those who traveled with you from home.**
- **The only open restrooms will be in the Family Life Center.**
- **Please use proper hand-washing hygiene while on campus.**
- **Access to many areas of the campus will be closed and/or restricted including the sanctuary, classrooms, conference rooms, some restrooms, offices, and kitchen.**
- **Extra hand sanitization stations will be made available.**
- **Please do not congregate before, during or after service. We will dismiss by section to avoid congestion after service.**
- **The church facilities will be cleaned and sanitized between weekly worship services**

*Attendees are encouraged to arrive approx. 15 minutes before service to allow time for temperature checks and seating. Service will begin promptly at 10:00am.
